Katie recently graduated from The Juilliard School with her Master of Music degree where she studied with the New York Philharmonic’s Robert Langevin. She received her Bachelor of Music degree from the New England Conservatory, where she studied under international flute soloist, Paula

Robison, who describes Katie as a “true, intelligent artist” with “a wonderful sense of humor and awareness of life’s surprises.”

She has performed in venues across the East Coast ranging from Carnegie Hall to the Sarasota Opera House. Katie shares her passion for the flute with her 31,000+ followers on her popular Instagram account, @katief flute, where she strives to make classical music readily accessible to all. Originally from outside of Reading, Katie was a member of the RSYO during high school. Her previous teachers include Robin Lilarose and Robin Kani.
